Gin

The Paul Hollywood - £10

Created in honour of Kent's Great British Bake Off host and his signature pork pie pastry. Pipehouse thyme and grapefruit gin from Tunbridge Wells. Served with tonic & garnished with apple and sage picked from the garden.

Kentish Lavender - £8

Chapel Down Bacchus Gin from Tenterden served with tonic, lime, and our home brewed lavender infusion.

Whiskey

Anno Whiskey (35ml) - £15

Two multi-award winning companies, Anno Distillers and Westerham Brewery produced Kent's first whiskey, which is serious and elegant with a strong young character.

Beers & Cider

Goachers Light Real Ale (3.7%) - £4.90

Maidstone, Kent. A pale amber light bitter with a rewarding floral hop character from the WGV and East Kent Golding hops.

Curious Brew Premium Lager (4.7%) - £5.10

Ashford, Kent. A premium lager of purity and freshness brewed using Galaxy and Cascade hops and the finest English malted barley. 330ml bottle.

Kentish Pip Skylark Cider (5.7%) - £5

Canterbury, Kent. Sparkling cider popping with big notes of fresh Kentish dessert apples, followed by a flourish of complex cider tannins. 330ml bottle.

Milkshakes

Honey & Cinnamon - £4.50

Paddock Wood, Kent. Taywell vanilla ice cream, Gardens honey and cinnamon.

The Pretzel Shake - £4.50

Paddock Wood, Kent. Taywell vanilla ice cream and salted caramel-pretzel.

Wine

Ortega 2019 (Bottle) - £30

Westwell, Kent. Fermented in stainless steel at slightly lower temperatures yields precise floral aromas of honeysuckle, grapefruit and peach.

Gribble Bridge Dornfelder 2018 (Bottle) - £30

Biddenden, Kent. Fresh raspberries and summer fruits abound in this refreshing, light red wine.

Ortega Rose 2019 (Bottle) - £30

Westwell, Kent. This rose wine has been fermented in stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures to retain freshness and purity. Co-fermented with ripe Regent to add notes of bright red crunchy fruit.

Chapel Down Sparkling Bacchus 2019 (Bottle) - £40

Tenterden, Kent. Chapel Down Sparkling Bacchus 2019 is characterised by aromas of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is tropical and floral with a crisp texture and a refreshing finish.
